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Start with KAIRI

A practical guide to instruments, signals, data status and history.

Read this first

KAIRI is informational, unvalidated analysis. It may be delayed, incomplete or wrong. It does not place or manage trades. There is no guaranteed daily signal and no validated 90% success rate. The ACCESS badge is a product label, not a performance certification.

Open the page

Sign in to Guardeer Prime with your normal account. Open **Prime Tools > KAIRI**. A valid Prime entitlement, an active device session and acceptance of the KAIRI agreement are required to read protected data.

Direct page: guardeerprime.com/kairi/. The **User Guide (PDF)** button in the top KAIRI card opens this document.

Choose your instrument

Instrument	What opens
XAUUSD - Gold	KAIRI research analysis using gold data. Original gold records remain available in the separate expandable history section.
EUR/USD - Forex	KAIRI research analysis. Original EUR/USD sealed records are available in the separate expandable section below.
BTC/USDT - Binance Spot	KAIRI research analysis using BTC priced in USDT. This is not BTC/USD, futures or an executable broker quote.

A simple reading order

1. Select the instrument. **2.** Check data status and timestamps. **3.** Read the latest analysis. **4.** Check whether a daily signal was actually published. **5.** Review its paper outcome in history.

One page, separate records: switching instruments does not move signals or results between the original ledger and current research.

Read the analysis

XAUUSD, EUR/USD and BTC/USDT: understand the difference between a setup and a published signal.

Latest analysis is not a published order

The **Latest analysis - not a published signal** panel shows the latest available assessment. **BUY setup** or **SELL setup** is a possible direction; it is not automatically selected for the day. Always check the separate **Server-selected daily research signal** section for a published record.

WAIT is a valid result

WAIT means no direction has been selected in the current analysis. It is not, by itself, a broken data feed. There may be no signal today. Wait for a published record instead of treating WAIT as BUY or SELL.

Understand the displayed result

What you see	What it means for you
BUY setup / SELL setup	A possible direction in the latest analysis, not a completed trade or a guaranteed daily signal.
No selected daily signal	No published plan is available for the current market day. Do not infer entry or exit levels.
Published daily signal	A research record with its own instrument, date and price levels. Review that record separately.
Unavailable or stale data	Current information could not be verified. Do not treat previously displayed levels as live.

Before reading a published signal

Check the instrument. Read the symbol printed on the signal itself. **Check the date and time.** A historical record is not a new signal. **Check freshness.** A connection or data warning takes priority over old displayed values.

Read the entry, stop loss, take profit and expiry together. These describe a research plan, not an order placed on your behalf. Their meanings and possible history outcomes are explained on the next page.

No badge, label, score or displayed direction is a verified probability of success. A BUY or SELL can result in a loss. KAIRI has no validated win rate and is not a substitute for independent judgment.

Read signals & history

Published research plans stay distinct from changing analysis and actual broker trades.

Check the signal's instrument

There is at most one server-selected daily research signal shared across XAUUSD, EUR/USD and BTC/USDT, not one for each. The daily signal and shared history can therefore show a different instrument. Always read the instrument printed on the signal card.

What the published fields mean

LIMIT entry: the proposed price for the paper plan. **Stop loss (SL)** and **Take profit (TP):** the plan's exit levels. **Entry expiry:** the last permitted entry time. **Research exit cutoff:** the plan's end time. These are research values; KAIRI does not submit them to a broker.

A published BUY/SELL is not a filled trade. The displayed entry may never be reached. A SELL on Binance Spot does not execute a short sale. Published plan levels are not rewritten by later analysis.

Outcome	Meaning
PENDING / CENSORED	Entry or outcome is not yet fully assessed. No completed result is established.
TP / SL	The candle-based paper model assessed a target or stop outcome. This is not a broker fill.
TIME_EXIT	The paper plan was assessed at its holding-time cutoff.
NOT_TRIGGERED	The entry was never activated under the simulation rules. This is not a loss.
AMBIGUOUS / DATA_FAILURE	Evidence is unclear or insufficient. Do not count this as a verified win.

Time and results

The signal availability window is **02:00-15:30 America/New_York**, with a **16:00** paper exit cutoff. Market-day labels roll at **17:00 New York**. Daylight-saving time applies, so do not assume one fixed UTC offset.

BTC data is available seven days a week, but research signals still use the decision window. EUR/USD follows the FX market week. Gold observes its market week and daily maintenance break. An untriggered published plan still uses the shared daily signal slot.

Net R is a paper result relative to the plan's defined risk unit, not a percentage return on your account. Costs are research assumptions, not measured execution costs. Empty history means no published records yet; past wins are not invented.

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Status & troubleshooting

Check freshness first. An unavailable or closed market is not a signal.

What you see	How to use it
CURRENT	Current research inputs passed freshness checks. Read the analysis; CURRENT does not mean BUY or SELL.
MARKET_CLOSED	The selected FX market is outside its scheduled open session. No current FX analysis is expected.
WAITING_FOR_DATA	The first research update is not available yet. Wait for new information, then refresh.
STALE / DATA_FAILURE	Fresh or complete inputs could not be verified. Do not treat old levels as live. Check again later.
Sign in / Access required	Use your normal Prime account and confirm the current device session. Accept the KAIRI agreement when asked.
Refresh failed / REQUEST_TIMEOUT	The request did not complete. Check your connection, refresh once, and try again later if the problem persists.

Refresh without changing the analysis

Use **Refresh analysis** for gold, EUR/USD or BTC research, and **Refresh server record** for the original ledger. Refreshing retrieves the latest available information; it does not force a signal. Avoid repeated clicks while a request is still loading.

Return to the KAIRI tab to check for updates. If the interface looks outdated after an update, reload the page; on a Windows browser you can use Ctrl+F5.

Original XAU and EUR records

The original ledger has its own **Current advisory** and **Daily Advisory Timeline**. **SERVER RECORD** identifies an authenticated record; **UI STATUS** is a waiting label, not a signal. Any **fictional demo** rows are layout examples, not performance history. Reference TP2 is informational; the original TP outcome is assessed against TP1.

Expand **Original sealed records for the selected instrument** to inspect the separate gold or forex history, then close it to return to the current analysis. Never combine the two histories into one success rate.

Operational email alerts are optional and are not required to use KAIRI. For persistent issues, share the instrument, visible status and timestamp with platform support - never your password or session tokens. [EULA](#) | [Privacy Notice](#)
